Financial Report - Meagan Jarecki

- Meagan reviewed the financial report distributed showing a cash balance of \$13,390 noting that expenses for pictures taken and the banquet are still outstanding. This balance is intentionally high as we have been saving in a capital fund for the impending expense of new uniforms to be purchased in the off season. Our fiscal plan includes a rolling balance target of approximately \$3,0000 - \$6,000 to account for necessary expenditures during the summer and long term expenses.
- Summer fundraiser (e.g. garage sale with ARC truck) was discussed as a means to accumulate the necessary cash flow to jointly invest in a 'shooting machine' with the boy's team; also, some new uniforms will be purchased for the next season.
