

**GLENMOORE EAGLE YOUTH ASSOCIATION**  
**MEETING MINUTES – OCTOBER 12, 2011**

**In attendance:** Paul Ricken, Al White, Rob Welsch, Jim Emig, Chip Ashenfelter, Mike Maher

1. The minutes from the September 14, 2011 meeting were reviewed and unanimously approved.
2. Baseball Report – Tom Graybill submitted the following report electronically:
  - a. Upper Uwchlan Twp aerated all of HP. Supposed to seed but haven't seen it completed yet. In process of getting a field usage credit for HP 4 from Spring 2011 (due to lack of drainage/usability) for \$2,000. Will follow up when we get final word.
  - b. Spoke with Al Gaspari/UUT....said that Cary (President of Park and Recs UUT) is hesitant to put up permanent fencing on HP 1 as it would lose it's all-purpose theme. Will continue to push on this.
  - c. Mud puddle behind HP 1 visitor dugout is still an issue. Gaspari said that UUT public works doesn't see it as an issue. I will bring up directly to public works supervisor
  - d. Boy Scouts are going to plant trees at HP. Looks like it will be done in the Spring 2012. Told them that GEYA would contribute some money towards project-- perhaps 50% up to \$1,500. Reviewed project with Gaspari and we looked at planting 13 trees around ball fields to provide shade.
  - e. Springton Manor field improvements.....the fields were fertilized and sprayed for weeds last week. Need to apply for a permit to get fencing up. Spoke with Wallace and are in middle of permit process. Might need to get a check for permit from Jim Emig but will email with details when we get to that stage. Waiting a bit to see if we get approved for a grant from Baseball for Tomorrow Fund (BFT) before we complete all of the work. Grant was applied for in September and takes a few months. The grant would potentially 50% of costs of fencing and field improvements at Springton Manor plus 50% of scoreboards at HP. Waiting for an indication yet one way or the other from BFT fund. Asked for up to \$40k for grant.
  - f. Starting work on populating new website w/ target "live" date of December 1 when registration opens.
  - g. In process of building 2012 calendar for baseball. Hope to get out by end December 1<sup>st</sup>. USTC in door practices have been booked.

- h. Safety Report.....Emailed dog bite family and they were really good about the situation and have moved on. Haven't gotten an update from West Vincent police regarding dog.....no new issues from safety perspective.
3. Soccer Report – Paul Ricken announced a new pre-school division, headed by Susan Barr, in conjunction with YSC (USTC). This is a feeder program for the Union (clinics, etc.). Currently there are 32 players in the program, which takes place on Thursdays at 10:00 and 1:00.
  4. Financial Report – Jim Emig reported that \$2,420 of September registrations are reflected in the October financials. A question was raised about the bank fees reflected on the financials. Jim noted that PNC charges 5% of receipts for internet registrations via credit card. The internet provider also takes a piece.
  5. A discussion took place confirming the location of the future GEYA Board Meetings. The meetings will continue to take place at the Eagle Tavern in Eagle, PA. The next meeting is scheduled for November 9, 2011.
