BOARD MEETING – May 8, 2013

Meeting was called to order at 8:01 p.m.

- 1. Legion –*
 - a. When players pay their registration fee for Fall season, checks should be made out to GEYA.*
 - b. We are in process of establishing a board for the Legion program*
 - c. Greg Amicon is looking to identify coaches for the Fall season. He is hopeful that we will have 2 teams in Fall season but some work still needs to be done.*
 - d. The Legion program should contribute some money towards field upkeep*
 - e. The website for legion is operational—no one on the current legion program has taken the time to get it updated though*
- 2. Baseball*
 - a. The baseball ceremony went well*
 - b. Jim Emig has a lead on some bleachers at the Spring City Veterans Administration that they don't use. He will contact them with thought that perhaps they will donate them to GEYA so we can have some form of bleachers on Tantala Field (HP 1). If not, it was discussed that it should probably be a priority item—perhaps in Fall 2013—to get some bleachers for the field. Upper Uwchlan Township took down the old bleachers that they had originally erected 20+ years ago because they were not up to code.*
- 3. Soccer Report (Paul Ricken)*
 - a. Soccer is in process of setting up Fall Registration.*
 - b. The thought of GEYA (both baseball and soccer) having a consistent policy for background checks was brought up. Paul Ricken will review EPYSA's policy on what is acceptable/not acceptable from a soccer standpoint. Tom Kent will get the Little League criteria. Overall, we would like to have a consistent policy in place on what would provide a pass/fail result.*
 - c. Soccer had 731 registrants for Spring 2013 season. They also have 14 kids enrolled in the Hi-Five program.*
 - d. Larry Greenberg created a group email address for the GEYA executive board. The address is execboard@geyasports.org.*
- 4. Treasurer's Report (Jim Emig)*
 - a. Financial statements were distributed and reviewed*
- 5. Old Business – Tom Graybill reported that the 4 AED/defibrillator units were ordered back in February. At that time they said there was no back order. Unfortunately they have not been*

delivered as of yet and we are told they are on back order. 2 heated/weather proof storage boxes have been ordered and received. We are hopeful to get them in ASAP and installed quickly. The Silva foundation is still in process of donating 2 of the units to GEYA.

6. *New Business – we need to get geya executive board website up to date. We should add dates on calendar for future meetings and continue to add meeting minutes as approved. Larry Greenberg and Tom Graybill will look to get things updated.*
