

## GEYA Sports January 2016 Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:40 by Larry.

1. **Soccer** report given by Chip Ashenfelter.

- Soccer opened registration on 1/2/16.
- Cindy Rodriguez taking over as registrar. This will be the current registrar, Barb Reisenwitz last season.
- Early bird registration discount of \$10 off goes until 1/15/16.
- At 220 or so registrations now.
- Number of coaches at 15 or 16.
- Season to start beginning of April. Finish first week of June. Dates are still TBD.
- Soccer budget due next month.
- Field house at Fellowship to be completed next month.
- Still looking for field space. Will lose Windsor Baptist after spring 2016 season.

2. **Baseball** report given by Dave Franz.

- Registration opened 12/15
- 95 players so far.
- About 50% of normal level.
- Registration closes 2/21/16
- Evaluations on 2/28/16
- Opening day 4/9
- 5/7 is Baseball celebration day.
- GEYA registration costs about double in comparison to other close leagues.
- Waiting to hear from UU Parks and Rec. board about several items.
  - Press box redo on field 2
  - Use of baseball of field 4
  - Bleachers on field 1
  - Effect of turnpike expansion on the park.

3. **Legion** report given by Gregg Amicon.

- Talks still ongoing regarding effort to unify Lionville and GEYA teams.
- There is objection from Bob Larosa. (former Legion charter owner) over name

changes.

- A few possible scenarios were discussed.
- Gregg will continue to work out the best possible outcome along with Lionville.
- The preferred outcome is a Legion organization with all teams having the same name. This would appear to present a more uniform and less confusing organization moving forward

4. **Treasurer's Report** given by Jim Emig.

- Budgets for Baseball, Soccer and Legion are due at the February meeting.
- 2015 was a very successful year. All financial goals were met.
- Tax return will be filed shortly.

5. **Old Business.**

- Soccer referee and lack of 1099 issue readdressed.
- Motion to start issuing 1099s to referees made by Chip.
- Vote went 6-1 for issuing 1099s to referees beginning in 2016.
- Suggestion of board is that soccer board require any person who is paid by GEYA to have a W9 on file before they begin working for GEYA.
- The board agrees that Marie Pantelone does not have responsibility for 2015 or any year previous prior to 2016.
