

## South Fayette High School 2017 Girls Lacrosse Registration Information and Fees.

The South Fayette Lacrosse Association will be holding an informational meeting on September 19, 2016 at the Cuddy Fire Hall at 7:00 pm. The meeting will address the High School Lacrosse program, and all parents are encouraged to attend. Board members and high school coaches will be present and available to give an overview as well as answer questions. Registration will open at the conclusion of the meeting for the 2017 season for girls in grades 9-12. Registration will be taken online at [www.southfayettelacrosse.com](http://www.southfayettelacrosse.com). All athletes interested in participating in the season should register ASAP regardless of availability in the fall or winter

### **Fees**

The registration fee is \$350.00/year, which is due at the time of registration. This fee will cover all sessions (fall, winter-gym, regular season, and \$50 for two tickets to the Rock Night Fundraiser) and applies to all participants. Cash, credit card, or checks payable to SFLA are accepted. A payment plan option will be available. Final payments will be due by January 30, 2017. Participation in off-season tournaments may require an additional fee that will be predicated based on participation.

### **US Lacrosse Membership**

A membership with US Lacrosse, the sport's national governing body, is **MANDATORY** since South Fayette Lacrosse, its players, coaches and all officials receive insurance coverage from US Lacrosse. Annual membership cost \$35.00 for ages 15 and up, which is a separate cost from the Registration fees, and is paid directly to US Lacrosse. If you already have a USLacrosse membership, you must renew your membership as needed to keep it active. Membership can be completed online at [uslacrosse.org](http://uslacrosse.org). Players will not be allowed to participate in any practice or game without an active membership.

### **Equipment**

All players will be required to supply their own equipment (sticks, goggles, mouth-piece)

### **Uniforms**

All uniforms will be provided to the players by the SFLA. All uniforms will remain the property of SFLA, and will be collected at the conclusion of the season. SFLA will make every effort to secure the preferred jersey number of the players, but is not guaranteed. Before uniforms are distributed, a post-dated check of \$125 will be required as a deposit. \*Athletes will be responsible for purchasing warm-up that will be required as outlined by Coach Moretti, returning players can use the same as last season. Warm -ups will become the property of the athlete.

### **Off Season Practices**

Coach Moretti plans to begin off-season conditioning and skill training will begin in the fall. Practice schedules will be communicated by the coach. Practices will be held in the evenings. Attendance at off-season practices is strongly recommended. Families are responsible for transportation to all practices.

### **Teams and Games**

South Fayette will field a VARSITY team and compete in the WPIAL for the 2017 season. While we **anticipate** having two teams, varsity and JV, the final determination to field multiple teams will be based upon the total number of eligible athletes registered and at the discretion of the coaching staff. Tryouts will be held in early March to determine the team rosters. Students at any grade may participate on either team. As with practices, games will be held in the evenings, and families are responsible for transportation.

### **High School Requirements**

Even though players register through the SFLA, they will also be required to "sign up" in the high school athletic office during the school designated time frame. Athletes must comply with all guidelines and regulations as outlined in the South Fayette High School Athletic Handbook, which will be distributed at the time of high school sign ups. No additional fees will be collected at that time.

### **Fundraising/Volunteers**

The SFLA High School teams will be functioning as a booster funded organization. There will be fundraising opportunities throughout the season, and all families are expected to participate. Two tickets for our annual Rock Night Fundraiser are included in registration and you are welcome to buy more if necessary. Information about additional fundraising opportunities will be communicated at a later time. There will be a \$50 deposit required for families to encourage assistance with volunteers for videotaping, scorekeeping, statistics, admission, concession sales and fundraising. Deposit will be returned upon completion of volunteer commitment.
