LYBA Coaches Code of Conduct

As an LYBA Coach or Manager:

1. I will maintain at all times, a positive attitude towards my players, game officials, opponents, parents, coaches, and LYBA Board of Directors.
2. I will encourage positive and constructive communication to and from players, parents, coaches, and LYBA Board of Directors.
3. I will not allow players or parents to conduct themselves in a manner that may compromise the integrity of LYBA or its affiliates.
4. I will develop players in the best interest of the entire team.
5. I will teach my players to respect and consider the feelings of our opponents whether we win or lose.
6. I will maintain a fun and constructive playing environment.
7. I will instill effort, teamwork and fun before winning.
8. I will ensure the safety and well being of my players at all times.
9. I will work to continually improve my coaching abilities.
10. I will devote at least 8 hours of service annually to LYBA beyond the coaching duties associated with my team (tryouts, tournament help, field day clean-up, JCJBL meetings, etc.).
11. I will attend, or have a representative attend in my place, the monthly LYBA coaches meetings.
12. I will conduct player and parent meetings no less than once a month.
