

Once read this needs to be approved by a vote of the General Membership and there must be a minimum of 10 people present to form a quorum for the vote to count.

The following is a proposed amendment to the Hillsborough Dukes By-laws regarding fundraising guidelines for post season competition and tournaments:

Article 14 –Fundraising

Section 2 - Post Event Season Fundraising

Any teams which may require fundraising for postseason or tournament competition will be required to adhere to the following conditions:

- No team may undertake any fundraising without the written permission of the Executive Board. Any collection activity must be reported to the board so that a board member may opt to be present for final accounting. Requests should be made by emailing the executive board at board@hillsboroughdukes.com and a board member will respond within 48 hours of the request.
- Any monies collected by the team will be distributed on an equal individual basis for the team presuming each member of the team participated in at least 75% of the fundraising activities. The coach/commissioner shall be responsible for determining an individual team member's participation rate.
- Those team members not participating in 75% of the fund raising activities will be subject to the full cost of any new expenses for postseason or tournament competition.
- Commissioner and coaches will make every effort possible to announce the total number of collection activities for the season.
- All monies collected by each individual team will be turned over to the board treasury for team accounting. No Coach or Commissioner shall hold any money for any team past the day of collection. All collected monies will be turned over to the treasurer or designee by the end of the day.
- Monies collected and not utilized by an individual team will at the end-of-the-year be used to suffice any deficit to the respective program's budget before reverting back to the football or cheer allocation for the following year's budget.
