



2018 CMNLL All-Star Eligibility Agreement

CMNLL is beginning its All-Star selection process. The first priority in team selection is to verify player eligibility. Eligibility is based on age, residency and availability. After verifying eligibility, teams will be selected that best represent our league. This year's selection process of All-Stars is detailed in the Post Season Information which [can be found here on our website](#).

To verify eligibility, please review the below-listed requirements, then sign and return this form to your manager no later than May 24, 2017. **Only players who return this signed form by May 24, 2018 will be considered for All-Star eligibility.** All-Star Players will be notified the week after Closing Ceremonies.

ALL STAR ELIGIBILITY PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS:

- All-Star players **MUST BE AVAILABLE** to participate in practices and games from June 4 to July 1, (or potentially to the end of August depending on the team's success in the tournament). Please note that this means no vacations or activities that would conflict with practices and/or games can be planned during this period.
- Player guarantees 100% commitment, positive attitude, best effort, and cooperation.
- Players must live within league boundaries, unless player meets exception rules.
- Parent **MUST** attend the All-Star meeting in June (date TBD), regardless of previous All-Star playing experience.
- Each player's family agrees that parents will work a 4-hour shift in the CMNLL Fireworks booth.
