

Code of Conduct

All players, coaches and spectators are expected to act responsibly and demonstrate sportsmanlike behavior at ALL Girls In House games, practices and other activities. At all activities, we want the players to have fun and get as much enjoyment and playing time as possible. We would like them to experience success and improve their present skill level and exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.

PLAYER CONDUCT Any player who:

- Uses profanity
- Throws equipment, bats or helmets
- Intentionally disregards softball rules
- Verbally abuses an umpire, coach or other players on either team

Shall be ejected from the remainder of the game, plus suspension from the following game.

Any player who physically abuses an umpire, coach, or other player is ejected from the game – no warning.

CYBER BULLYING of team members, coaches or opponents will not be tolerated, and may result in suspensions. This includes phone texts, Facebook and myYearbook postings. Threats of violence will be turned over the Police Department for investigation.

COACH CONDUCT

Coaches are expected to maintain GREAT examples of sportsmanship for both players and adults. Verbal abuse of umpires, other coaches, or players WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

Any coach who:

- Uses an ineligible player – game is declared a forfeit
- Calls “ball”, “strike” during a game will be given 1 warning before ejection from the game. Ejection is not subject to protest.

SPECTATOR CONDUCT

If a spectator demonstrates unsportsmanlike behavior toward umpires, coaches, players or other spectators they will be asked to leave the game area. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit of the team they are associated with.

This rule is not subject to protest.

****Any physical violence during any Girls In House activity will result in the Police Department being notified of this violation. This rule is in affect for ALL persons attending a game; umpires, coaches, players, parents and spectators**

*****Physical violence may result in permanent suspension from all BAC programs*****

It is the policy of BAC that no Player, Coach or Spectator may use tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs at games / practices.
