

Borrowing Rules for Majors and Minors DMALL Divisions

DMALL encourages all teams to always play their games instead of having to re-schedule because of not having enough players available to play. In order to facilitate this, all teams should actively borrow players from other teams when faced with less than 9 players. The borrowing should be facilitated by the manager in need of player(s) directly to the family of the player asked to be borrowed. The borrowed players manager does not need to be involved in order to lower the number of communications involved in securing a borrowed player.

The following three rules govern all borrowing of players for all DMALL games and will also be expected of any DMNLL team that a DMALL team is scheduled to play as well.

- 1) The player being borrowed can come from any team in the same division but must be selected from the pool of players designated by the division coordinator. That pool of players consists of the bottom half of any team's roster as determined by the player's selection in that season's draft.
- 2) Once a player is playing as a borrowed player, they cannot play the positions of catcher or pitcher
- 3) Once a player is borrowed, they must bat in the last position in the batting order.
