DUTIES AND RESPONSIBIITIES – COACHES

- 1. Encourage and **practice** good sportsmanship.
- 2. **Do not** argue with the referees. Remember, they are high school students. If you have a problem, take it to your coordinator.
- 3. Coaches should review BYBA rules with their players.
- 4. Be sure to call each team member before each game for at least the first 3-4 games.
- 5. Encourage your team to go home after the game rather than stay in the field house
- 6. Be sure to come equipped each week with pen, pencil, scoring sheet, rotation schedule
- 7. If you cannot make a game, please arrange for someone else to cover and let your league coordinator know.
- 8. Sometimes we have had coaches who did not adhere to the rules. This created the wrong environment for the youngsters. If you believe, from past experience, that you cannot adhere to these rules, please let your coordinator know so that we can find a replacement coach now. If problems occur during the season, we will ask you to stop coaching.
- 9. Coaches are responsible for communicating with their players to ensure each player arrives thirty (30) minutes prior to a scheduled game.
- 10. Prior to the last regular season game, coaches must complete evaluation forms for each player on their team. Completed evaluation forms go to the coordinator.
- 11. Record all scores on a weekly basis and turn in score sheets to the coordinator.
- 12. Coaches must make themselves available for the skills' contest.
- 13. Coaches will notify players of team assignments.
- 14. Coaches will keep track of personal fouls on the score sheets. Any player who commits 5 personal fouls will be disqualifies.
