## Silent Sidelines – October 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup>

The weekend of October 18<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> has been designated as Silent Sidelines. What is Silent Sidelines? This is when parents refrain from excessive cheering and 'coaching' from the sideline. The goals of Silent Sidelines are to develop our players to make decisions on the field without sideline intervention, improve the players' communication on the field by reducing the outside noise level, and support our youth referees by eliminating dissension from the sidelines. The guidelines are simple. Spectators are to be quiet, talking in a normal tone to the person next to them. What is to be avoided are comments that can be heard by players, referees or opponents. Applause is permitted and encouraged. The program works and increases the awareness by coaches and players. See the story below:
