II	<p><b><u>Approval of Prior Meeting's Minutes</u></b></p> <p><b>A.</b> Note: Handout minutes have an error. Embroidering and screen printing on player packs is being done by Friday's Threads. Motion to approve by Rhonda Peischl, seconded by Missy Block.</p>
III	<p><b><u>Treasurer's Report– Rhonda Peischl</u></b></p> <p>Rhonda provided an updated snapshot of the monthly finances for Mason Men's Lacrosse. Of note was the \$1,000 deposit from Superbowl fundraiser, expecting check from MABA for Football playoffs in the amount of approximately \$1500, The boosters had to purchase 5 new helmets for the 2017 season due to wear and tear. DeAnna was able to negotiate with the AD to split the cost of the helmets between the boosters and the school, so the boosters will be responsible for \$462.50. In response, the boosters agreed to be responsible for Coaches yearly registration fee of \$25.00. The school also has paid the \$500 Midwest tournament fee for the Team. Preseason breakfast was a success, thank you to all who volunteered. There was approximately \$108 surplus from breakfast fund which was used to pay for a snack bag for the boys on banner picture day.</p> <p>Motion to approve budget report was made by DeAnna Malloy, seconded by Clint Hutson.</p>
IV	<p><b><u>Old Business</u></b></p> <p><b>A. MABA Update – DeAnna Malloy</b>            DeAnna reported that MABA is looking for a Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer. A noted perk is Fee Admission to Mason home football games. If interested in either of these positions, please contact DeAnna.</p> <p><b>B. Uniform Distribution</b>            DeAnna reported that uniform distribution went very smoothly. Thank you to the board members who were able to help to distribute all day on Saturday. It was noted that one bag was missing from the group of bags. In looking at last year's check-in sheet shows bag not returned. Calls will be made to players family in attempt to retrieve bag, uniform and helmet. If unsuccessful the boosters will take the situation to Scott Stemple for help retrieving the missing items.</p> <p><b>C. V	<p><b><u>New Business</u></b></p> <p><b>A. Player Packs</b> At this point all Player Pack fees have been collected, the Board has unanimously voted to cover the long sleeve grey shooter shirt for all players. Most of the pieces have arrived and DeAnna is working on getting them to Friday's Threads for embroidery and screen printing. We are hoping to have all player packs distributed by the Hudson game.</p> <p><b>B. Spring Sports Night – March 13<sup>th</sup></b> This is mandatory for all players who did not attend the Fall or Winter Sports night. Typically Coach will have a meeting for all players and parents following the meeting by Stemple. As of now, we have no details on a team meeting.</p> <p><b>C. Hudson Trip – Snacks/Hotel</b> DeAnna will put together a sign up genius for parents to sign up for box dinners for the Hudson trip for both nights as Hudson Booster will not be providing a meal to us on Saturday. In addition the board will provide "snack" bags and drinks for the bus ride up to Hudson and the return trip to Mason.</p> <p><b>D. Youth Clinic/Youth Night – April 29<sup>th</sup></b> It was brought to the Boards attention that the girls LAX Comet Cup tournament is on April 29<sup>th</sup>. In addition, the Youth program has its annual lax tournament in Carmel, IN that day. These potential conflicts will be brought to Coach Limpert's attention to see if rescheduling is an option.</p> <p><b>E. March Madness – Jim Sipe</b> All squares are sold! 	<p><b><u>Fundraising</u></b></p> <p><b>A. Dine &amp; Donate</b> City BBQ brought in \$352 from our Meet the Team night and we earned \$88.14. Other ideas - Popcorn.</b> The Concessions Coordinators want to try some new products to help bolster sales this year in concessions. One idea was the flavored glazed popcorn. VII	<p><b><u>Committee Updates</u></b></p> <p><b>A. Concessions</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Sign Up Genius was sent out to gather parent volunteers to run concessions during home games. It was asked that every family sign up for 2-3 slots in order to support the concession stand. As of this meeting almost all the spots have been filled. There are a handful of identified families that have not signed up – DeAnna will reach out to them and give them an opportunity to choose their slot, otherwise they will be assigned an opening and notified of their shift.</li> <li>b. A new popcorn maker was delivered on Thursday. After negotiating with the Athletic Department and MABA, Men's Lacrosse is responsible for \$200.00, Football and Band are responsible for \$400 each.</li> </ol> <p><b>B.
