Football Playoff Recap – 17 different people work over 3 games for 55 points (the most points!) gross was \$18,000, net profit number will be available in December. b. Payouts should be finalized next month. May take a few months for money to hit our school account. <p>B. Down's Syndrome Holiday Party Recap – Kids had a blast. Both head coaches were there.
