Girls Volleyball ADDENDUM
REVISED Spring 2018

1. Coaches will record all scores using www.csalden.org When reporting scores, include the following:
 - a. Individual games: 2-0, 2-1, 1-2. Do not include scores for each game.
 - b. The third match will be recorded only if the game was necessary to play.
2. The first 2 games will be played to 25 and the third game will be played to 15. The third match will be played if both coaches agree.
3. A match can begin and/or end with 5 players. If the game begins with 5 players, the team will not be penalized by the "ghost serve". If a player is disqualified during a match and a replacement player is not available, the team will be penalized by the "ghost serve".
4. Players may enter the game after the game begins only if their names are written in the book prior to the start of the game.
5. All official fees will be paid to CSAL before the team's first match. Schools will pay their post season tournament fees at the completion of the tournament.
6. Coaches must declare to the opposing coach and officials any player who is not on the original roster (approved only by the CSAL Director-regular season only). Any player not participating in mandatory play (JV 50% of the match, Varsity 25% of the match) must be declared to the opposing coach and officials.
7. Coaches are to present their official roster to the score keeper before the start of each match. Rosters on the CSAL website are considered to be the official roster.
8. JV may serve from a serving line marked 3' in from the end line
9. Warm up for each match is 5 min. Visitors, 5 min.
10. Games without a score will be considered a tie for tournament seeding. It is the responsibility of both coaches to report scores including tournament matches.
11. Players must participate in 70% of the regular season schedule in order to play during the post-season tournament.
12. Spandex or shorts classified as a spandex style may not be worn as an outer garment.
13. Teams using a Libero must have a libero tracker sitting at the scorer's table.
14. After being clearly released or thrown from the hands of the server, the ball shall be cleanly hit for service (EXCEPTION: If, after releasing or tossing the ball for service, the server allows the ball to fall to the floor without being hit or contacted, the service effort shall be canceled and a re-serve directed. However, the referee will not allow the game to be delayed in this manner more than one time during any term of service).

Volleyball Playing Requirements:

JV and D3/D4 Varsity:

-50% of the game, one full game or 25 points of the anticipated scheduled game. Playing time is to be completed before the start of the 3rd game. The coach must make a concerted effort in playing every player during the 3rd game.

Varsity D1 and D2:

-Every player should participate in 25% of the match, including the 3rd game. If the 3rd game is played as a scrimmage, minimum play should have occurred during the first two games.

Every effort should be made before and during the game to remind coaches of playing time guidelines by the officials, the opposing coach, sport's director, athletic director, CSAL director, or a volunteer at the scorer's table. If a coach is reminded during the game of playing time, the official scorekeeper must document the warning and the book must be signed by both coaches. The warning must occur with enough time/points for playing time rules to be satisfied. Consequences may include: suspension of coach, forfeiture of game, and expulsion from tournament.
