Parent/Guardian Section-

- 1) Parents should support the efforts of the volunteer coaches and of NSYL.
- 2) Parents should set the right example for your child by always showing good sportsmanship
- 3) Parents will not argue with a coach, referee or official at any Stanwood Lacrosse involved event.
- 4) Parents use of profanity, drugs, alcohol or tobacco during any Stanwood Lacrosse involved event is prohibited.
- 5) Any parent who crosses onto the field during a game risks their child being disqualified from play.
- 6) Parents and spectators will remain on the side of the field opposite from the players (where applicable).
- 7) Parents should never voice any complaints or concerns towards coaches, referees or league officials in front of the children.
- 8) Understand that our child will be given every opportunity to participate; however, the safety of our athletes is our number 1 concern.
- 9) Parents should praise a child's efforts and always offer support. Please allow your child to play as child and have fun.
- 10) Parents who do not comply with the rules as outlined by NSYL and Stanwood Lacrosse run the risk of expulsion.

Player section-

- 1) Players will try their very best to support their team.
- 2) Players will be team players and always put the team first.
- 3) Players will stay within the team areas of the sidelines during games.
- 4) Players will accept their coaching and be ready to learn and have fun.
- 5) Players will listen to the coaches and officials, follow the rules of NYSL and of the sport.
- 6) Players will demonstrate good sportsmanship on and off the field of play and will not be malicious or retaliate.
- 7) Players will attend all practices, games, meetings and any other team function on time.
- 8) Players will show respect towards all coaches, players, and officials at all times.
- 9) Players will not fight, use foul language or argue with coaches, teammates or officials.
