LEE FRANCONIA FOOTBALL LEAGUE CODE OF CONDUCT

ALL PARTICIPANTS IN LEE FRANCONIA FOOTBALL LEAGUE (LFFL) ACTIVITIES (ADMINISTRATORS, PLAYERS, CHEERLEADERS, COACHES, OFFICIALS AND SPECTATORS) ARE EXPECTED TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PRINCIPLES OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP AND APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR AND WILL COMPLY WITH ALL LFFL POLICIES, RULES AND PROCEDURES. THIS CODE OF CONDUCT APPLIES AT PRACTICES, GAMES AND ALL OTHER LFFL-SANCTIONED ACTIVITIES.

Participants will:

- Exemplify behavior that reflects good sportsmanship, respect, courtesy, and a positive attitude.
- Maintain self-control at all times.
- Refrain from using abusive language or profanity, making humiliating remarks, gestures of ill temper, verbal or physical threats, and/or physical assault upon another player, coach, official, or spectator.
- Not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any player, cheerleader, coach, official, or spectator.
- Treat players, cheerleaders, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, religion, or ability.
- Follow field/facility rules and regulations, respecting at all times the property of others.
- Not use alcohol or illegal drugs, or carry any firearm or weapon during any event in which LFFL is a participant.
- Not smoke tobacco on the field or in the bleachers during games or practices.

ANYONE WHO VIOLATES THIS CODE OF CONDUCT IS SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM ANY LFFL EVENT AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION UP TO AND INCLUDING BEING EXPELLED FROM ALL LFFL ACTIVITIES. ALLEGED VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT SHALL BE REFERRED TO THE LFFL COMMISSIONER OR ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER FOR INVESTIGATION, TO INCLUDE INTERVIEWING THE PARTIES INVOLVED.
