After the Round Robin: West Cup will be teams 1,2,3,4 (round robin) Scholastic Cup will be team 5 of the top tier, and then teams 1,2,3 (round robin) Founders Cups will be teams 4,5 from the middle tier, and then teams 1,2,3 and 4 (single game elimination)</p> <p>JV will be split into 5-4-4, with the first round being a round robin.
