

ILLINOIS WEST ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY FOR SPECTATORS AND PARENTS

PARENTS/SPECTATORS:

The game will be stopped by on-ice officials when the parents/spectators displaying inappropriate and disruptive behavior interfere with other spectators or the game. The on-ice officials will identify violators to the coaches for the purpose of removing parents/spectators from the spectator's viewing and game area. Once removed, play will resume. Lost time will not be replaced and violators will be subject to further disciplinary action by Illinois West, and may be subject to further disciplinary action by their club. Illinois West will suspend the parent/spectator for a minimum of four (4) consecutive league games (not including the game of violation). A second offense can include further disciplinary action up to and including season suspension for all remaining games including playoffs. This inappropriate and disruptive behavior shall include:

- Use of obscene or vulgar language in a boisterous manner to anyone at any time.
- Taunting of players, coaches, officials or other spectators by means of baiting, ridiculing, threat of violence or physical violence.
- Throwing of any object in the spectator's viewing area, player's bench, penalty box or on-ice surface, directed in any manner as to create a safety hazard.
