

CLINTON YOUTH FOOTBALL AND CHEERLEADING

COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT & AGREEMENT

As a Clinton Youth Football Coach, I hereby pledge:

1. To never place the value of winning above that of instilling the highest desirable ideals and character traits in my players.
2. The safety and welfare of my players must never be sacrificed for any personal prestige or glory. I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of my players ahead of my personal desire to win.
3. To do my best to provide a safe playing environment for my players.
4. To provide a sports environment for my team that is free of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and profanity. I will refrain from their use at all youth football practices, games and events.
5. To lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players at all times.
6. To be knowledgeable of the SYFC's rules and teach these rules to my players. Both the letter and spirit of the rules must be adhered to by all coaches.
7. To use coaching techniques appropriate for the skills that I teach.
8. To encourage players to accept responsibility for their behavior and performance and never condone unacceptable behavior.
9. To ensure each player is wearing the proper equipment and uniform for each practice and game.
10. To respect and accept the decisions of all game officials and avoid words or actions that are unsportsmanlike.
11. To be courteous and direct when dealing with league officials and opposing coaches.
12. Not to make demands of my players that will interfere with the player's opportunities for achieving academic success.
13. To not permit an ineligible player to participate in a game.
14. To emphasize that winning a game is the result of teamwork.
15. To take the necessary courses and safety training and obtain the proper certification (if necessary), as required by the Shoreline Youth Football Conference.
16. To provide league mandated breaks during practices, including but not limited to water breaks for my players, as outlined in the SYFC's By Laws.
17. To complete a Background Check Form and submit it to the CYF&C Board for processing prior to the first practice of the season.
18. To share any parent concerns or complaints (that cannot be reasonably resolved) with the CYF&C Coaching Director, Vice President or President.
19. Not to permit anyone on the game field /bench to allow uncomplimentary remarks to any official during a game.
