

CLINTON YOUTH FOOTBALL AND CHEERLEADING

PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT and GAME DAY VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

All parents/guardians who have children participating within the Clinton Youth Football and Cheerleading organization on must abide by a code of conduct which includes the provisions that follow.

Any violation of these rules may result in the revocation of privileges in the league.

- I/we hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parent's Code of Conduct.
- I/we will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, cheerleaders, coaches and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sport event.
- I/we will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desires to win.
- I/we will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I/we will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Conduct.
- I/will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I/we will demand a sports environment free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I/we will remember that game day is for youth - not ADULTS.
- I/we will do my best to make youth sports fun for my child.
- I/we will ask my child to treat other players, cheerleaders, coaches, fans, parents, and officials with respect regardless of race, creed, sex or ability.
- Upon request, I/we agree to furnish the required documentation to Clinton Youth Football & Cheerleading, which may include proof of Birth (i.e. Birth Certificate, Current Passport, etc.), a Report Card, and other required American Youth Football documentation of the applicant.
- I will support my child's team/squad and teach the value of commitment, emphasize the ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
- I will read and review the Player Code of Conduct with my child.
- I/we agree to be financially responsible for the equipment and uniforms issued to the applicant other than normal wear and breakage during games and practice. Further, I/we will reimburse Clinton Youth Football & Cheerleading for the loss and/or damage to said equipment and uniforms.
- I/we agree NOT to smoke on the practice or playing field, or in the presence of a gathering of a team/squad.

- I/we agree to abstain from the possession and drinking of alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of any illegal substance at any Clinton Youth Football and Cheerleading functions.
- I/we agree not to deliberately incite or participate in "unsportsmanlike" conduct at any Clinton Youth Football & Cheerleading function.
- I/we agree not to use abusive or profane language at any time at any Clinton Youth Football & Cheerleading function.
- I/we agree not to criticize, belittle, antagonize, berate or otherwise incite the opposing team, its players, coaches, cheerleaders or fans by word of mouth or gestures.
- I/we agree to show courtesy to officials and accept all decisions of the game officials/judges, as being fair and called to the best of their ability.
- I/we agree to follow the proper chain of command when filing a complaint or voicing my/our opinion regarding any possible rule infraction or concern within the CYF&C or SYFC. (As follows):
 1. Head Football / Cheer Coaches
 2. Coaching/Cheer Director
 3. Vice President
 4. President
- I/we agree to take responsibility for any actions that violates this code of conduct by a guest or relative of attending parents/guardians.

Any act of disrespect from a parent/fan directed towards game officials/judges, or Conference officials, that creates a disturbance either in the stands or on the playing field, or results in an ejection from a game, practice or event by the SYFC official or game official, will be addressed accordingly, according to the SYFC By-Laws.

GAME DAY VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

I agree to work my assigned shift for my child's team/division on game day for Clinton Youth Football and Cheerleading. If I do not work the shift assigned to me for whatever reason, and do not find a replacement, **I understand that I will be charged a \$50 No Show Fee.**
