



BATTING CAGE RULES

- **ADULT COACH** must operate pitching machine.
- Absolutely **NO PLAYERS** inside shed with machine at anytime.
- Players *must* enter and exit through the cage door, not the shed.
- Batting Cage for registered players only (**no siblings or adults**).
- No one, except batter, in cage while machine is on. Exception: Adult coach giving hands on instruction.
- Helmet must be worn by all batters.
- Machine to be turned off while balls are being retrieved in the cage. Anyone can enter cage and help retrieve balls while machine is off.
- **DO NOT SHARE** the combination to the shed/cage with players.
- Be considerate of others that are using the cage or those that are waiting to use the cage; stick to your allotted time schedule.
- When finished (if no one else is waiting):
 - Shut off and unplug pitching machine.
 - Pick up all balls and return them to the bucket.
 - Rake the stone dust. The surface should be smooth and even.
 - Please remove any trash and leave the area clean and neat.
 - Check and re-lock all the locks on the shed and cage; if you have a problem with the locks or machine – notify the league immediately – **do not just leave the shed or cage open**
- Please report any problems to the league immediately.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF BATTING CAGE PRIVILEGES FOR THE SEASON
