

Northshore Lacrosse Club Code of Conduct

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. "HONOR THE GAME" of lacrosse by displaying good sportsmanship on and off the field. Lacrosse is a team sport: I am on a team and I will be a team player.
2. **Scholastics shall take precedence over lacrosse**
3. I will adhere to NLC's zero **tolerance for drug, alcohol and tobacco use**. If you choose to use, there will be consequences commensurate with the individual circumstances that may include suspension or removal from the team.
4. I will always follow the basic rules of **Fair Play**. I will respect the rules of the game, my opponents and the officials and their decisions. I personally will maintain self-control at all times.
5. Players are required to be on time for practices and games. "On time" means fully dressed and equipped to play for whatever time is set by your coach for that practice or game. **If you require more time to dress, come earlier.**
6. Players shall be at every game and every practice except for illness, injury or school events. If a player must miss a practice or game, he must notify his coach in advance
7. Foul language toward anyone, be it teammates; coaches; officials; opponents or spectators, will not be tolerated.
8. Players shall not be critical of teammates and never discuss teammates abilities expect to encourage good team play.
9. Players shall maintain appropriate conduct whether they are winning or losing, getting scored upon or having just scored a goal. Excessive celebrations in these situations are considered unsportsmanlike.
10. Players are responsible for their own equipment, and thus, they must ensure that it is complete, safe, and in good condition at all times.
11. Players shall conduct themselves in a dignified manner at all time. Each player represents the game of lacrosse, NLC and their team.

PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. I will encourage my child "Honor the Game" of Lacrosse.
2. I will support the coaches, officials, and club officers working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all
3. I will praise my child for trying hard and competing fairly.
4. I will never ridicule or yell at my child, other players, coaches, or officials.
5. I will respect all officials and their decisions. I understand that all officials do their utmost to be impartial, provide a safe and suitable playing framework and see that the game is well played.
6. I will not use profanity, nor will I harass players, coaches, officials or other spectators.
7. I will remember that my child plays lacrosse for his enjoyment, not mine.
