

How is FC Nashoba different than other clubs?

- Nashoba FC is a volunteer organization run by individuals who are focused entirely on player development, as well as making competitive soccer available at a reasonable cost.
- Beginning in the Fall of 2014 when Nashoba FC begins placing teams into the “premier” leagues, players can reduce their training to more acceptable levels – for those players in both Nashoba United and Nashoba FC, team practices will be held jointly. This allows players who want to play in both recreational and club soccer to do both and limit practice days to 2x per week with 2 games on the weekend.
- Nashoba FC will include a majority of players from the 3 towns that make up the Nashoba Regional High School soccer program.
- Costs – Nashoba FC will participate in MAPLE or other competitive (“select”) leagues at a fraction of the cost normally charged – this is accomplished by small but focused volunteer structure, shared resources (fields, common uniforms, consolidated equipment cost, etc.)

What is Nashoba FC?

Nashoba FC is a new program administered by Nashoba Regional Soccer Association (NRSA) – previously known as Nashoba United. Recent expansions of the program have resulted in the creation of 2 divisions – Nashoba FC and Nashoba United - now allowing players to participate in both recreational soccer and “club” soccer at significantly lower costs than currently charged by existing programs (such as FC Stars, NEFC, Aztec, Scorpions, etc.). Nashoba United will continue to be administered as a recreational soccer program and participate in NVYSL, while Nashoba FC will begin league participation in MAPLE or other more competitive leagues beginning in the Fall of 2014.

Program Details for 2013/2014 Development Program:

Total Program Fee: \$375/player (3 payments of \$125)

- The program is open to all participants (with enrollment capped at 30 players per gender)
- All participants will be provided with a Nashoba FC practice jersey
- The Nashoba FC Development Program does not conflict with any existing recreational or club soccer registration (although training schedules and indoor schedules might conflict so parents should ensure they can accommodate the dates/times)

Fall Training:

- Location: Forbush Fields
- Days/Times: Sundays from 12:30 to 2:00
- Start Date: 10/6/2013

Winter Training:

- 3 Sessions of Indoor at Forekicks in Marlborough (each session includes approximately 6-8 indoor games) - details available on the registration site
- Six to eight weeks of indoor skills training – days/times TBD – (focused primarily on ball control/foot skills)

Spring Training:

- Location: Forbush Fields
- Days/Times: Sundays from 12:30 to 2:00
- Start Dates: Mid-April to Mid-June

Additional Costs:

Optional Tournament Play - Costs for entry into the tournament will vary based on participation – expect cost to be approximately \$45/ per player for each tournament.
