

2016 CHPBA Draft Procedures

- 1) The goal of the draft is to make as fair teams as possible to promote league parity
- 2) Every player shall be graded by the managers and – if available – a league grader. The players will receive scores which will be used to rank the players into 12 tiers, representing the 12 rounds of the draft which will ultimately place 12 players onto each team. At the draft, each manager will receive one pick per round of the draft. However, if the manager has a child in the draft, the manager will not choose a player in the round corresponding to the tier in which their own child appears (so if the manager's child is slotted in the 2nd tier, the manager's child would be that manager's 2nd round pick). Other than the manager's player (or players in the case of siblings), there is no requirement that any player – regardless of tier – be taken in a round corresponding with that tier. Managers are free to use their draft pick for any round in which they choose to pick any player otherwise available in the draft.
- 3) In the case of siblings, upon choosing one sibling, the other sibling must be chosen in the round corresponding to the tier in which they were ranked, unless the parents have otherwise requested that they not play on the same team.
- 4) The first round's draft order will be determined by the lowest point total of each of the manager's children. After the first round, the team's point total shall be determined by the players actually on the roster, with each subsequent round proceeding with the lowest aggregate point total choosing first, and the highest aggregate point total choosing last.
- 5) In recognition of the time and work that goes into managing a team, managers are encouraged to make all efforts to accommodate reasonable coaching requests.
