

All Star Fall Ball Program

The CHPBA All Star Fall Ball Program is available to existing CHPBA summer all star teams. Such existing teams may request entry into the CHPBA All Star Fall Ball Program (any such team, an "All Star Fall Ball Team"). The manager of each All Star Fall Ball Team shall be subject to the approval of the Fall Ball Committee, taking into consideration prior coaching experience, parent evaluations of the manager and other relevant factors. Each All Star Fall Ball Team will be "age based" (e.g., 9U, 10U, 11U, 12U, 13U, etc.) as opposed to "division-wide" (Mustang, Bronco, etc.) unless otherwise approved by the Fall Ball Committee. An All Star Fall Ball Team will be considered full if all existing players on the applicable existing CHPBA summer all star team are rostered on such All Star Fall Ball Team or such All Star Fall Ball Team is comprised of at least 12 players (although such All Star Fall Ball Team, subject to the approval of the Fall Ball Committee, may carry less than 12 players). **NOTE: THESE TEAMS ARE BEING FORMED ONLY FOR THE FALL SEASON AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO STAY TOGETHER AS A TEAM DURING THE REGULAR SPRING SEASON, AS SPRING SEASON TEAMS ARE FORMED PURSUANT TO A DRAFT FORMAT.**

CHPBA all stars who participated in the immediately preceding summer all star program and who are not affiliated with a particular All Star Fall Ball Team (each, an "Additional Player") may also be eligible to fill open spots on the appropriate "age based" All Star Fall Ball Team. If there is space on an All Star Fall Ball Team and there are interested Additional Players, the Manager for such All Star Fall Ball Team, the Division Commissioner (from the preceding spring season), the Manager of the summer all star team for that interested Additional Player(s) (e.g., a B team manager if his players are being considered to fill an open spot) and the Fall Ball Commissioner shall meet and select the Additional Player(s) to fill the open spot(s) based on skill level, overall team composition, attitude, and other factors relevant to the formation of a competitive "travel ball" or "club" team. The CHPBA President may participate in such selection meeting. It is possible that interested Additional Players may not be selected to fill an open spot on an All Star Fall Ball Team and in such event, such Additional Player may elect to participate in our instructional fall ball program.

The approved All Star Fall Ball Team manager will determine what competitive "travel ball" league the All Star Fall Ball Team will play in (e.g., South Bay, Mid-Valley, Sherman Oaks). The All Star Fall Ball Team will not play in our instructional fall ball league.

Registration fee to be \$80/player (subject to change at the discretion of the Board) plus the cost of the fall ball league the All Star Fall Ball Team will participate in. This fee will cover practice time at Cheviot, insurance and 2 boxes of balls. Registration fee will not include uniforms, although the All Star Fall Ball Teams may use existing CHPBA All Star Uniforms or purchase their own uniforms (out-of-pocket).

The All Star Fall Ball Team may decide to hire a private coach to coach such team, provided that such private coach is subject to the approval of the Fall Ball Committee and all costs for such private coach are to be paid out-of-pocket by the parents of such team. Players will be notified that private coaches may be hired at the cost of the team and, in such event, if such players do not wish to pay for such private coaches, they may withdraw and receive a refund or participate in our instructional fall ball league.

Each All Star Fall Ball Team may participate in other tournaments at the team's discretion and expense.
