PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT CONTRACT

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in the Phoenix Lacrosse Club /Arizona Youth Lacrosse League organization by following this Parents' Code of Conduct Pledge:

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all participants, Coaches, Officials, Board Members, at any organization-sponsored event, either at home or away.
2. I will demand an environment for my child that is drug free and alcohol free at all league sponsored events.
3. **I will remember that the sport is for the youth and not adults.** I will not use the team as a baby-sitting service, and I will supervise my child in the program as well as any other children I bring to the field. This includes all practice and games.
4. I will do my best to make this organization fun for my child.
5. I will ask my child to treat other participants, coaches, board members, parents, and spectators with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
6. I will, along with any guest of mine, refrain from any vulgar, lewd or obscene language or gestures while participating in or watching any league sponsored event whether at home or away.
7. I will strive to be a good role model for my child and the other children in the program. I will encourage my child to learn to lose with dignity and win with grace.
8. I will direct all my questions, concerns or comments regarding parents, participants, coaches, or officials **away** from the children participating in the league. When expressing my questions, concerns or comments, I will conduct myself in a calm, civilized manner. I will not disturb the coach, parent, or board member when they are busy working and/or coaching, but will speak to them at an appropriate time. An appropriate time is defined to be: ***"at the conclusion of a practice or game when all participants have been dismissed and the coaches have finished meeting", or by email contact.***
9. I will respect my child's coach and do my best to have my child at all practices on time. I will recognize the importance of volunteer coaches. I realize they are important to the development of my child and the sport. I will communicate with them and support them. I will not interrupt them during games or practices.
10. I will never yell at or physically abuse my child before, during or after the game.

2013-2014 Phoenix Lacrosse Club Discipline Policy & Procedures Form

All players are subject to the rules and expectations of the **Phoenix Lacrosse Club Code of Conduct**. In a situation where the player is in violation of the code of conduct the following actions may need to be taken.

The **Phoenix Lacrosse Club** reserves the right to institute a three strike policy:

1. **First violation:** Suspension from the next game or scrimmage as of the date the violation occurred. The player will not be allowed to participate in the game or scrimmage, and not be allowed on the sideline with the team.
2. **Second violation:** Suspension from team for one week as of the date the violation occurred. The player will not be allowed to participate in team practices, scrimmages, or games during this time period, and not be allowed on the sideline with the team.
3. **Third violation:** Expulsion from the team. The player will no longer be allowed to participate in team practices, scrimmages, or games for the remainder of the 2013-2014 AYLL lacrosse season, and not be allowed on the sideline with the team.

Any violation will result in a conference with the player(s), parent(s), and coach(s) regarding the violation during practice, scrimmage, or game. After such conference has occurred it will be at the team's Board of Directors discretion to proceed with the discipline policy or document it as a warning.

- Refusal to meet and abide by this process will result in automatic dismissal from the team, as stated in policy # 3.

I understand and support the **Phoenix Lacrosse Club Discipline Policy & Procedures**.

In the event of expulsion from the team after January 15, 2014, I am aware that no financial refunds of any kind will be available. I have discussed this policy with my son and agree to the conditions mentioned above.
