**Tuition Overview**

In general the tuition has been established by the Board of Directors of Nashoba Youth Hockey Association, Inc. to ensure that the association covers all the costs associated with operating the program. Examples of costs associated with operating the program include, but are not limited to the following:

- League fees, practice ice, skills clinics, shirts and socks, coaching education, league playdowns/playoffs and administrative costs.

As an association seeking non-profit status, we need to ensure that we fully cover all the costs of the program and reduce any risk associated with non-payment and/or delinquent payment of tuition fees.

**Registration/Evaluations**

All players must pay a \$200 registration fee to Nashoba Youth Hockey Association, Inc. at the first evaluation date and submit a completed registration form. \$100 of the fee is non refundable and is used to pay for the cost of the evaluations. A refund request for \$100 must be received by the Treasurer in writing or via email by May 15. There will be no refunds for any requests received after this date. The registration fee is meant to hold a position for the player on the active roster and is considered a prepayment to the full tuition for the next season.

Tuition for the Learn to Skate, Learn to Play Hockey and In House Mites are due at the time of registration and payment must accompany a completed registration form.

**Tuition and Payment Schedule for the Season**

Girls U16 - \$350

Girls U12 and U14 – \$1,075

Midgets – \$400

Bantam –\$1,250

Peewee - \$1,250  
Squirt - \$1,250  
Mite Travel - \$1,250

Full-time goalie - \$600

In-House Mites – \$475  
Learn to Play Hockey – \$165  
Learn to Skate – \$125

An incremental fee of \$100 per family is applied to the Girls U12/U14, Mite Travel, Squirt, Peewee and Bantam levels.

### **Multiplayer Discount**

A family with three or more players will receive a base tuition discount equal to 20% for the third player and 50% for the fourth and any subsequent player.

### **Tuition Assistance**

Tuition assistance is available to NYHA applicants and is granted on an individual basis. All requests must be submitted in writing and must be received by the Treasurer prior to the first current payment due date. Tuition assistance is provided in two formats; alternative payment plan or tuition relief.

*Alternative Payment Plan* – A written agreement is reached between the applicant and the Board to a schedule that is different than the current payment policy of the Association. The player will remain on the active roster if the payment plan is followed.

*Partial or Full Tuition Relief* – A written agreement is reached between the applicant and the Board to a new tuition rate for the season.

All requests for tuition assistance will be kept confidential and you will be notified in writing of your approval or denial as determined by the Board.

### **Requests for Refunds**

All requests for a refund due to the withdrawing from the program after a player's tuition has been paid must be done in writing, to the Board of Directors of Nashoba Youth Hockey Association, Inc. Upon receiving the request, the date of withdrawal will be established. Tuition refund requests to the NYHA, Inc. Board of Directors will only be considered for cases of illness or injury that prohibit the player from participating in the sport of ice hockey for the balance of the current hockey season. No refund will be granted for any reason other than the aforementioned. The NYHA, Inc. Board of Directors decision will be final and the refund, if approved, will be subject to the availability of program funds.

### **Failure to Pay**

Failure to pay any installment due based on the payment schedule above, or as determined via tuition assistance, will subject the member to removal from the active roster for the current and future seasons.

**Returned Checks**

There will be a \$25 charge for each returned check.
