Finance - Tuition Policy

2018/2019 Season (September 2018-April 2019)

Tuition Overview

Tuition levels have been established by the Board of Directors of Nashoba Youth Hockey Association, Inc. to ensure that the association covers all the costs associated with operating the program. Examples of costs associated with operating the program include, but are not limited to the following:

- League fees, practice ice, skills clinics, jerseys and socks, coaching education, league playdowns/playoffs and administrative costs.

As an association with non-profit status, we need to ensure that we fully cover all the costs of the program and reduce any risk associated with non-payment and/or delinquent payment of tuition fees.

The Nashoba Youth Hockey Association tuition policy and team assignment process for the 2018-19 hockey season is outlined below. Payments will be spread over a number of months to ease the tuition burden on our members. Tuition is required to be paid in full by August 15th. If tuition is not paid in full or if there is an outstanding balance from a prior season, your child will not be issued a team jersey and will not be allowed to participate in NYHA activities.

Registration/Evaluations/Placement

All players must pay a non-refundable \$100 registration fee to Nashoba Youth Hockey Association, Inc. and complete an online registration form prior to the first evaluation date for the following season. Players will not be allowed to participate in their age level evaluation session if the registration fee is not paid and online registration form has not been completed. In April, players will be assigned to the appropriate Nashoba hockey team. At that time, the second tuition payment will be due. The second tuition payment is meant to hold a position for the player on the active roster. Non-payment of the 2nd tuition fee may jeopardize their initial evaluation placement.

The payment schedule is listed on the following page. The projected tuition amount is subject to change by up to 10% based upon increases in league fees and ice time rentals.

If a skater is playing on two teams, the total tuition will be the combination of the higher full team tuition plus the alternate tuition. For example, if a skater is on the PW and Girls U12 team, the tuition would be \$1,700 + \$750 = \$2,450.

Family discounts will be 20% of the lowest tuition amount for the third child and 50% of the lowest tuition for the fourth child. Discounts will also be applied to initiation program tuitions.



Alternate Skater Policy

Alternates must be approved in advance by the NYHA Director of Player Development. To become an alternate, the skater must be a registered full time member of another, non-Valley League hockey program. Alternates can attend practices and games at the coach's discretion. Alternates cannot attend skills or goaltending skills sessions. If an Alternate is not placed on a team, the \$100 registration fee will be refunded.

Alternates are not allowed for Midgets or the High School Girls Teams.

Initiation Programs

Each Initiation program is run twice per season. Tuition for the Learn to Skate and Learn to Play Hockey are due at the time of registration and payment must accompany a completed online registration form.

- Learn to Play Hockey – \$200 per session
- Learn to Skate – \$150 per session

Refund Policy

The February registration payment is non-refundable. Other amounts paid, will be fully refunded prior to team assignments. Once teams are assigned, 50% of tuition paid will be returned prior to August 15th. After August 15th, tuition is non-refundable. All requests for a refund due to the withdrawing from the program after a player's tuition has been paid must be done in writing to the Board of Directors of Nashoba Youth Hockey Association, Inc. Upon receiving the request, the date of withdrawal will be established. Tuition refund requests to the NYHA, Inc. Board of Directors will only be considered for cases of illness or injury that prohibit the player from participating in the sport of ice hockey for the balance of the current hockey season. No refund will be granted for any reason other than the aforementioned. The NYHA, Inc. Board of Directors decision will be final and the refund, if approved, will be subject to the availability of program funds.

Returned Checks

There will be a \$25 charge for each returned check.

Tuition Assistance

Tuition assistance is available to NYHA applicants who are in need due to financial hardship. All requests must be submitted in writing and must be received by the NYHA Treasurer prior to the first current payment due date. All alternative payment arrangements must be agreed to in writing and will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to adhere to the agreed upon tuition payment schedule. Failure to pay promptly will result in your child not being allowed to participate in NYHA activities.

Tuition assistance is granted on an individual basis and is provided in two formats; alternative payment plan or tuition relief.

Alternative Payment Plan – A written agreement is reached between the applicant and the Board to a schedule that is different than the current payment policy of the Association. The player will remain on the active roster if the payment plan is followed.

Partial or Full Tuition Relief – A written agreement is reached between the applicant and the Board to a new tuition rate for the season.

All requests for tuition assistance will be kept confidential and you will be notified in writing of your approval or denial as determined by the Board.
