Gridiron Minutes – Nov. 21, 2017

Meeting called to order at: 6:35 p.m. by President Rick Bouchard

A motion was made to approve minutes; Tito Roderick and Ron Pastor approved.

Coach's Corner: *Coach Mike Drury reported*

- Coach Drury reported that the freshman and JV teams ended their seasons undefeated.
- Coach Drury said the varsity team will practice every day. Although there is no school the day before Thanksgiving, the players have film at 1:45 p.m. Senior moms will decorate the locker room at 5:30 p.m.
- The players are to arrive at the high school for 6 a.m. for Thanksgiving morning breakfast. The bus will leave at 8 a.m. and it's Senior Day for Cheshire High School.

- Rick reported that the freshmen finished the season 10-0, and the concession stand was opened during their last home game.
- The JV team canceled their game with South Windsor because of lack of players, so JV played Glastonbury and finished their season 9-0.
- Rick said a meeting will be held regarding a benefit for Dan Bird, to determine location and how to raise the most funds for him.

Treasurer's Report: *Eric Clark reported*

- Eric reported that the concession stand was open during the freshman game and made \$75. We sold 87 total program books. We have 13 left.
