Gridiron Minutes – Dec. 5, 2017

Meeting called to order at: 6:35 p.m. by President Rick Bouchard

Coach's Corner: *Coach Drury Reported:*

- Coach Drury said that we are now in the off season and evaluations began on Dec. 6, two weeks before Christmas. He will soon distribute training dates and times. He said the team has a good head start and are ready to go.
- Evaluations began, with the older players getting their numbers, and the younger players learning techniques.
- Coach said that he is looking around for a winter 7 on 7 program and is getting prepared for next season.
- The banquet is coming up and college coaches are coming in to visit prospective high school players.

Officer Reports:

President: *Rick Bouchard reported:*

- Rick reported that gifts have been ordered for the banquet, and Awards of Elegance has the roster and design of varsity plaques.
- Rachelle and Rick will go over planning of banquet with Coach Drury. Rick reported that we are good to go with Dominello for tuxes, and Rachelle will coordinate that.
- The Gridiron will start looking into offseason planning and will do a cookie dough fundraiser
- Rick said the Gridiron is now looking into new members for the Executive Board and Committees as the transition will happen in March. He said it's a good opportunity for parents – especially sophomore and freshmen parents – to get engaged.

Treasurer' Report: *Eric Clark reported:*

- Eric said that there were not many expenses which included helmet stickers and pink socks.
- He will be printing out 1099 forms for the coach stipends/
- There was \$160 in revenue from freshmen game fan gear and concession, and there are also 13 program books left to sell at the banquet.

- Eric summarized the budget, saying there was \$80,000 collected, and with meals and expenses, we came in under budget. The major upcoming expenses are the coach's stipends, repair to the Gator and the banquet. He reported that we have sufficient funds to move forward.
- The budget will have approximately \$22,500 left after coach stipends.

Fundraising: *Rachelle Campbell reported:*

- Rachelle reported on the Dan Bird event, and set up a meeting to discuss the benefit. Several businesses would like to be involved, depending on what type of event we do.
- There was some discussion on whether to involve the players in the benefit event.
