Coach Commitment Statement

If selected as a Travel coach, I will:

1. Spend the time necessary with my team at practices and games required to ensure the continued growth of the players I will be responsible for coaching.
2. Teach players fair play, good sportsmanship, and respect for the opponent, umpires, and rules of the game of softball. I will encourage parents to reinforce these principles through leading by example.
3. Attend WLGSL Travel Committee recommended and funded coaching clinics and training sessions (e.g., Coaching Conventions, PCA training).
4. Ensure a Team Manager is selected for administrative requirements of the team and that the Team Manager handles the requirements ethically, timely and following guidelines provided by the Travel Commissioner or Committee.
5. Be responsible for proper safeguarding and use of all equipment and facilities to which I have access. I will ensure uniforms conform to Travel Committee requirements and guidelines of associations to which my team may be subject during the season (e.g., USSSA, PONY, ASA).
6. Learn and abide by all rules and regulations for the field/tournament on which my team will be playing.
7. Refrain from using bad or abusive language, alcohol, drugs, or tobacco while around the team.
8. Abide by the financial reporting requirements as defined in the operations manual, the WLGSL Constitution and its By-laws.
9. Work with and support the WLGSL Travel Committee to benefit the league, when and as requested (supporting try-outs, supporting fundraising events, participate in coaches clinics for the WLGSL Recreation League, etc.)
