Code of Ethics

Article 2. Players:

- 2.1** Players shall perform to the best of their abilities and abide by all AYAA rules and regulations.
- 2.2** Players shall treat their coaches, game officials, and opponents with respect at all times regardless of race, gender, religion, or playing ability.
- 2.3** Players shall attend every practice and game that they can. If they cannot attend they shall notify their manager or head coach.
- 2.4** Players shall resolve conflicts without resorting to any form of hostility or violence.
- 2.5** Players shall always try to achieve a high level of sportsmanship and encourage the same from fellow players. Players shall refrain from taunting, trash talking, using profanity, fighting, and refusing to shake hands.
- 2.6** Players shall always remember that participation in AYAA programs is a privilege and they shall respect the game and the playing facility.
- 2.7** Players shall leave their playing environment in a clean and sanitary condition.
- 2.8** Players shall treat this sporting experience as an opportunity to learn and above all have fun. Players will alert their parents and coaches if their sporting events stop being fun.
- 2.9** Players shall always understand that school academics are their number one priority.

Article 4 Parents and Spectators:

- 4.1** Parents shall be responsible for their child while said child is participating in or watching a sporting event. Parents will also be responsible for themselves while participating in or watching a sporting event.
- 4.2** Parents and spectators shall encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support and showing respect for all players, coaches, and officials at all sporting events.
- 4.3** Parents and spectators shall place the emotional and physical well being of players ahead of a personal desire to win.
- 4.4** Parents shall support coaches and officials working with their child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- 4.5** Parents and spectators shall demand a sports environment free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and they will refrain from their use at all sporting events.
- 4.6** Parents and the spectators shall remember that the game is for youth and they will do their part to keep the game fun.
- 4.7** Parents shall ensure that their child treat other players, coaches. spectators. and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed or ability.
- 4.8** Parents shall support their child, team, and program by carrying out their duties such as but not limited to fund raising, hall monitoring, stand duty, and providing transportation.
