

<b>RULE</b>	<b>Explanation</b>
Bat	BBCOR Certified Only
Spikes	Metal Spikes are permitted
Dead Ball	Dead Ball - When playing action ends - players must request/call time and the umpire needs to grant time to be considered a dead ball.
Fielding	Infield Fly <u>DOES</u> apply.
Innings	Games are 7 Innings. Time permitting, extra innings will be played until a winner is determined.
Mercy Rule per Game	10 After 5
Mercy Rule per Inning	Unlimited Runs Allowed
Misc	Minimum players to play is 9
Misc	Complete Game = 5 innings played. If the home team is ahead after 4 1/2 innings, the game is considered complete
Pitching	Re-entry is prohibited.
Pitching	No pitching restrictions.
Pitching	Balk rule is in full effect.
Running	Runner must avoid contact at all times.
Sliding	Head first sliding is allowed.
Time	No time limits in place unless field being used has been reserved for another game.
Line-Up	If a coach chooses to bat his whole bench, free defensive substitutions are allowed. A coach may also choose to bat 9 or 10 (EH/DH). Free defensive substitutions are not allowed when team is not batting bench.
Courtesy Runner	No courtesy runners
Mound Visits	Pitcher must be removed on second mound visit in the same inning or the third overall visit for the same pitcher.
Injuries	If a player is injured and unable to play, the spot in the lineup can be skipped in the batting order without penalty. If the player is removed while on the bases, the player who the last out was made against will be inserted as the baserunner. Once the injured player is removed, he may not re-enter the game.
Umpires	2 umpire per game.
Umpire Fees	Split between the two teams.

Behavior	Unsportsmanlike behavior by anyone at the game will not be tolerated. This includes players, coaches, fans, parents and anyone else in attendance.
Weather	The home team is responsible for checking diamond conditions.
Baseballs	Home team is responsible for providing game balls.
Playoffs	TBD.
