SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Penn Kingsmen Lacrosse seeks to promote the sport of lacrosse. When funding and circumstances allow, Penn Kingsmen Lacrosse will provide financial assistance to cover a portion of the registration fees of a limited number of players who have desire to play lacrosse, but have financial obstacles in their way. The number and amount of registration fee scholarships will vary depending on the number of requests received and the amount of scholarship funds available.

Families requesting assistance must complete a scholarship application for each child prior to the registration deadline. Scholarships are not renewed and scholarship decisions will be independent each season, depending on requests and funds available.

The Penn Kingsmen Lacrosse Board will convene a scholarship committee to review all applications and make scholarship recommendations to the board. Funds will be allocated based on a majority vote of the full board, taking into consideration the recommendations of the scholarship committee. All decisions will be based on need, with individual circumstances taken into account where possible. The number and amount of scholarship dollars available will vary annually based on availability of funds.

To avoid conflicts of interest, board members, officers, or coaches who submit a scholarship application on behalf of their child will not be eligible to serve on the scholarship committee or to participate in any scholarship award deliberations.

All scholarship applications and related decisions will be kept confidential within the Penn Kingsmen Lacrosse Board.
