

Orland Park Pioneer Parental Code of Conduct

All parents/guardians who have children participating within the Orland Park Pioneer Organization must abide by a code of conduct, which includes the provisions that follow. Failure to abide by these rules or any rules set forth by the Orland Park Pioneer Organization will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following.

- Documented, verbal warning by Coach and/or Athletic Director.
- Suspension from teams events such as practices, games, etc. (along with written documentation of incident kept on file by the Athletic Director)
- Parental and or participant termination from the team/organization for the season (No Refunds), subject for review for any other subsequent years.

1. I will remember that this sport is for the benefit of youth, not adults.
2. I agree not to threaten a coach, official, board member, athletic director, participant, other parent or guest of Orland Park Pioneer Organization.
3. I agree not to use abusive or profane language or actions at any time at any Orland Park Pioneer Organization function.
4. I agree to abstain from the possession and drinking of alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of any illegal substance at any Orland Park Pioneer Organization function.
5. I agree to be financially responsible for the Pioneer Organization equipment/uniform issued to participant other than normal wear and tear during games and practices, further I will reimburse the Pioneer Organization for the loss and/or damage to said equipment.
6. I agree not to deliberately incite and/or participate in "unsportsmanlike" conduct at any Orland Park Pioneer Organization function (i.e.; using cheers or chants that would insult or taunt the opposing team or its fans)
7. I agree to accept all decisions of the game officials, judges or officials as being fair and called to the best of their ability.
8. I agree to treat all children and adults while at any Orland Park Pioneer function with respect.
9. I agree to be responsible for notifying the coach of any injuries, illnesses, or health problems which may affect their child's athletic ability.
10. I agree to be responsible for contacting the coach or assistant coach, BEFORE their child misses any practices or games.
11. I agree not to interfere with the coach's duties during practice or games.
12. I agree to be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice, competition or event.
13. I understand that problems and concerns are handled on an individual basis and that if I am unable to resolve any issue with the team coach and/ or Athletic Director I will then contact the President of the Orland Park Pioneer Organization.
