

Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Other League's in Milford

1. **What if my son is between 5 - 12 years of age, but we do not live in Calf Pen Meadow, Orchard Hills, Live Oaks or the East Shore Middle School Districts. Where do I go to register him?**

Milford is currently divided into two Little League boundaries. If you are not in Calf Pen Meadow, Orchard Hills, Live Oaks or the East Shore Middle School Districts, then you should register with Milford National Little League. Their information can be found at:

2. **My daughter is between 7 - 14 years of age and interested in playing Girls Softball. Where do I go to register her?**

Our league runs the only official Little League softball program in Milford. The program is City-wide, across all school Districts and does not have boundaries like the boy's program. The only requirement is that player's residency is in Milford. We offer four divisions of Softball - Coach Pitch (age 7/8), Farms (age 9/10), Majors (age 11/12) and Juniors (age 13/14).

3. **What if my son is 13 or 14 years old and wants to continue playing baseball in Milford, where do I go to register him?**
