Meeting Minutes from the 9/28/2016 meeting were reviewed and approved

1. AA Fees and tournament fees

a. \$225 for AA per team/ same cost as City Wide or Regional Tournament (also \$225)

2. Webmaster

- a. At present do not have anyone (at end of meeting Gene conducted a brief tutorial on how to use/access the West Region website need to be able to upload documents and send emails to area/district representatives.
- b. Jeff's goal is master email system this is not done and may not happen in 2017.
- c. Green Diamond \$15k grant perhaps use to reduce post season tournament fees (currently \$225).
 - i. Use of funds to encourage participation
 - ii. Assumption is that \$15k will be equally divided amongst the 4 regions
- d. Regional webmaster will NOT act as a conduit for all registrations in the West Region/ each area/district will handle
- e. Need a 4th Board Member to comply with the revised formation documents of GCK.

3. Rules:

- a. No Pitch Intentional Walk revised in light of catcher's balk call in Citywide Tournament (catcher lined up more than 6' outside of batter's box allowed winning run to score)
 - GCK expanded Rule 17 to allow for automatic intentional walks (with the ball being in play). No impact on pitch count as well.
 - ii. This modification approved.
- b. Bat Rule (re-write of Rule 15)
 - i. Discussed in some detail particularly the penalty provision (ejection of manager).
 - ii. Rule approved for West Region
- c. Hurdling/Plowing Rule
 - i. Also discussed in some detail was the re-write of Rule 29).
 - ii. Key is that any attempt on the part of the offensive player to slide will eliminate applicability of this Rule.
 - iii. Judgment call presumption is intention of offensive player not to hurdle/plow into the runner but this presumption is rebuttable based on the actions of the offensive player
- d. Rule 2 was also modified player can only play in a game if he/she can perform all of the actions required in a baseball game (run, throw, swing a bat, and catch a ball).
 - i. Any player who can not perform these functions (each of them) is not eligible to play.

- ii. Adaptive baseball programs available for kids with disabilities.
- e. A copy of the Rule Modifications needs to be posted to the website (West Region)
- f. All proposed rule modifications approved and will be reviewed and discussed at the next West Region Wide Meeting.
- g. But this will NOT happen until final approval is forthcoming (and it is anticipated it will occur) from GCK.
- h. New rules will require some additional umpire training.
- i. GCK will conduct an open meeting on Monday, November 21 to discuss the rule changes and obtain any feedback
- 4. CRC may appoint one person to coordinate use of all CRC fields by GCK teams located within the City.
 - a. Goal is to encourage efficient use of fields.
 - b. Discussion of need for fields for practice and game time and non usage is not necessarily an indicator of importance of the field being available.
