

Thank you for your interest in Watertown's Girls U19 Tier 1 team

Watertown has decided to enter a girls U19 team into Tier 1 for the 2016/2017 season. We believe that there is a need for such a team in our geographic area. Our U19 team, the CT Jr Eagles, will consist of 15 - 18 players and 2 goalies. Our team will focus on being "Prep School Friendly", which we know is of extreme importance to many of you and your players.

The mission of our U19 team will be the following:

- To focus on player development by partnering with IPH Hockey
- To focus on goalie development by partnering with Procrease Goaltending
- To compete in tournaments that will give players college exposure
- To compete at the New England Regional & National level
- To allow players the time they need to focus on studies, to participate in school activities, and get proper rest during their school hockey season
- To keep the fees affordable for families

Our Fees will be \$1600 for the season, with an emphasis on completing most games prior to Thanksgiving (with the exception of holiday tournaments and regional playoffs). Fees will include:

5 Home games (at least 5 away games)

14 Full Ice Practices (of which at least 6 will be run by IPH)

A minimum of 6 goalie development sessions run by ProCrease

Jerseys and socks,

The entry fees for 4 tournaments

The only additional costs that could be incurred would be the fees for the New England Regional & National Tournament (if qualified) and travel associated with tournaments or away games

We will be running 3 separate tryout dates for the U19 team. Cost for the tryouts is \$100 per player (non-refundable). The tryout dates and locations are:

Sunday March 6th 4:00 - 5:00 at Mays Rink at Taft School in Watertown

Sunday April 10th @ 2:20-3:40 at The Sports Center of CT in Shelton

and

Saturday April 23rd @ 6:30 - 7:50pm at The Sports Center of CT in Shelton
