2017-18 Player Code of Conduct

As a member of the Texas Bay Area Lacrosse high school program, each player has the responsibility to conduct themselves in a manner that best represents their team, Texas Bay Area Lacrosse (TBAL), and the Texas High School Lacrosse League (THSLL).

Accordingly, each player accepts the following terms as his eligibility to participate in TBAL's activities. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action up to and including immediate dismissal from their team for the duration of the season. As determined by the TBAL Disciplinary Committee.

- 1) **Grades:** TBAL will enforce UIL rules for grades and participation in athletic events. Grade reporting will be required to validate eligibility.
- 2) **Electronic Media:** In alignment with the CCISD policy on misuse of computers and the internet, players will not post or send electronic messages that are damaging to another player or coach's reputation or are damaging to TBAL.
- 3) **Inappropriate Behavior:** (Includes but is not limited to):
 1. School Suspension (ISS, OSS, DAEP)
 2. Unsportsmanlike or Violent Behavior
 3. Unlawful consumption of alcohol
 4. Unlawful use of drugs

Disputes relate to the TBAL Code of Conduct will be reviewed by the Disciplinary Committee.
