PARENT / GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. Be committed to your athlete's sport participation by making every attempt to have your athlete attend every practice and game, dressed and ON TIME.
2. Advise the coach if your athlete cannot attend a scheduled practice or game.
3. Be supportive of your athlete's coach.
4. **Do not shout comments from the viewing area unless you are supporting your child or the team.**
5. **DO NOT COACH YOUR CHILD FROM THE SIDELINE.** This confuses your child and undermines the coach's ability to coach your child to her full potential.
6. Do not approach any opposing team coaches or the officials at any time unless you have a positive comment to make.
7. Obscene language or gestures at any time will not be tolerated.
8. Refrain from the use of alcohol, tobacco or any illegal substances at games or related events.
9. Reflect the philosophies of Girl's Lacrosse Club of Frisco ("GLCOF") by respecting other teams, coaches, spectators and officials.
10. Do not step on the field of play before or during athletic competition.
11. If you have an issue with your child's coach after a practice or game, YOU MAY NOT discuss it after a practice or game. Follow the steps outlined in the Dispute Resolution process.
12. Remember that the five best words you can say to your child after a practice or game are: **"I love watching you play!"**

- I will ask my student to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
- I will promise to help my student enjoy the youth sports experience, being a respectful fan, providing transportation or whatever I am capable of doing.
