

District and City Tournaments

We discussed the district tournaments to be held in June. Following is a summary of that discussion:

We have a certain number of slots available to us for the City Tournament. These are listed in the second column. Some teams will get bids to the City Tournament depending on how they do in the regular season. These are listed in the third column. Other teams will get bids to the City Tournament based on how they do in the District Tournament. These are listed in the fourth column. In DSR, CSR, and CJR, we may be able to place more teams in the District Tournament if we choose. This depends on how many teams the other Districts place in the Tournament.

The District Tournament is single elimination, with seedings based on season record. It is open to all teams in the District that do not get an automatic bid to the City Tournament. The teams will be responsible to pay the umpire fees. The only fee is to pay the umpires each game you play. Umpire fees for the District tournament are as follows:

- A - \$45 per umpire
- B - \$40 per umpire
- C - \$35 (one umpire) – each team pays \$17.50
- D - \$30 (one umpire) – each team pays \$15.00

The Host areas will contact teams to ask if they wish to participate in the District Tournament. They must make their decision by 6/8/10 (6/15 for A League).

The brackets will be published by 6/12/10 (6/19/10 for A League).

The tournaments will be completed by 6/26/10 (7/3/10 for A League).

For DJR, we will have an end of season event at Blue Ash on 6/26/10. Teams will have a chance to play at least two games. District 4 DJR rules will be used. For this class, teams may combine to form teams.

City Tournament

The City Tournament will start July 7th. We are in the North region. It is a double elimination tournament. Basically you will play every other day until you lose two games or win the tournament. The four regional winners meet in the City Finals which are scheduled to end July 31.

Entry Fee for the **City Tournament** is \$175.
