Castro Valley Independent Sports League allows a team to protect certain players from the open draft by declaring them a “Frozen” player on a particular team. A team may elect to freeze as many as 6 players, total. These players must be the managers and two coaches’ siblings at a minimum. The other frozen players can be from the pool of players. These players will remain on this team for the duration of that player’s time in the team’s respective division.

A player once frozen, is always frozen with a particular division. If a player decides after playing with this team in question the first year that they no longer want to play for that team the succeeding year, this player must return to the open draft.

Exception to this rule is if the team returning does not have any coach or manager to return to that team as a manager, then the team is dissolved and any previously frozen players are free to find frozen player status on any other team where the number of frozen players does not exceed the 6 frozen player limit.
