



## MANAGER AND COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth not adults.
2. I will be a positive role model for my team players, fellow coaches and families. I will encourage sportsmanship by showing respect, courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players.
3. I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing, taunting and refusing to shake hands or using profane language or gestures.
4. I will enforce that my players treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect.
5. I will never ridicule or yell at my players or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
6. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
7. I will demand a sports environment for my team that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
8. I will praise my players for competing fairly and trying hard, and make them feel like winners every time.

**I acknowledge and agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action included in but not limited to the following:**

- Verbal warning by official, division coordinator, or a CVISL Board Member, if present at the time.
- Written Warning –Offending person will be advised in writing of the offense and further advised that repetition of the offense shall result in a more severe penalty.
- Manager/Coach Game Suspension - The offending person is to be advised in writing that he/she has been suspended from all League activity for a specific number of games or days.
