

## 2016 Bruins Draft Policy

In the event that there are enough players in any one age group to form two teams the following procedures should be followed.

- 1) After an agreed upon practice period, players will be divided into separate teams of equal talent and ages.
- 2) Player selection will be a draft by head coaches of each team by means of alternate picks.
- 3) In the event there are 2 or more siblings in any age group either coach will have to accept each one of those brothers/sisters thereby using that number of draft picks.
- 4) In the event any teams coach or coaches have a son or daughter they want to be on their team, that coach or coaches will automatically get that player or players on their team. The opposing coach will have his or her pick of an equal number of players before the draft begins. After that the 1<sup>st</sup> pick will be decided by a coin toss and begin the draft until all players are assigned to a team.
- 5) No consideration will be given to players having played together in previous years or due to living in same neighborhoods or to arrange car pools.
- 6) Once the draft is complete coaches have a time period agreed upon by the board to trade players if needed to ensure that each team has enough players to fill the proper positions.
- 7) Parents are not to be given rosters until the draft is final.
- 8) Once the draft is final there will be no moving of players among teams.

9) In the event there is a player or players that are registered late, those players will go to the team that didn't get the last draft pick or to the team with the least number of players. Subsequent players will be assigned to a team alternately in the order they register.
