Davis Lacrosse Association Player Admittance Policy for Spring Programs

It is the hope and desire of the Davis Lacrosse Association to provide opportunities for all local youth to have the opportunity to play lacrosse. In part this means that the number of players per team will be limited so players that are attending practice and working hard will get play time. Fulfilling this goal requires that the organization have a sufficient number of qualified coaches <u>and</u> a sufficient number of players.

It is the policy of Davis Lacrosse Association that whenever there are more players registered for a U13 or U15 team than there are spots available, tryouts will be held to determine if a player will be admitted to a team.

To be considered for tryouts, a player must be registered online at the Davis Lacrosse Association website and have established a membership with US Lacrosse that extends to at least the end of May. All required paperwork and payment for the spring program needs to be received on or before the registration close date. If a player is not accepted onto one of the teams, the registration payment will be returned in full.

At this time, a player's admittance for U11 and U9 teams will be determined by the date payment is received for each player's registration. Once the predetermined number of spots is filled, a player's registration will be put on a waiting list and will only be admitted if a player already on the team drops.
