Professional Coaching Criteria

The Easton Redding United Soccer Club (ERUSC) Board of Directors established mandatory professional coaching at all games and practices. The ERUSC has appointed both Joel Barlow High School Varsity coaches as its Coaching Director's (CD). The role of the CD's is very important. By establishing a professional curriculum and screening quality coaches, the CD's ensure that all professional coaches being used have the necessary skill-set to train our players. The following credentials must be met in order for any professional coach to be eligible for consideration by our CD's;

COACHING LICENSING REQUIREMENTS:

- USSF / State "D" or higher
- UEFA "B" License or higher
- NSCAA Advanced Regional Diploma or higher

OR

- Current high school head or assistant coaches with CBE permit

OR

- Current college head or assistant coach

STATUS:

- No professional coach will be allowed to provide coaching services to any team where a relative appears on that team roster.
- The Professional Coach must be listed on the team's certified roster as the head coach.
- No Professional Coach will be allowed to be listed as head coach on more than 3 rosters.
- All Professional Coaches must be first aid and CPR Certified.

Parent volunteers add to the effectiveness and camaraderie of a soccer team and will continue to be utilized by the ERUSC. Team managers or parent assistant coaches should assist in organizing the day-to-day activities of the team and to support the paid professional coach as well as to policies of the ERUSC Board of Directors and the CD. Voluntary parent managers and coaches are valued within our system to assist the professionals, but should not be running games or practice sessions on their own. If a professional coach has an occasional conflict, it is their responsibility to provide professional coverage or to reschedule a session.
