Tournaments – Scheuneman

- For 2019 and moving forward, JCATS will participate in the Maine East and Glenbrook North tournaments (MLK Weekend).
- West Dundee is a new tournament we are trying this season. Used to make up games due to Border Battle cancellation. Single day round robin. Will evaluate future participation.
- 7th /8th Grade away tournaments have been posted. Walters working on securing hotel on Friday night for 7-8 O/B teams and Saturday night for 7-8 White.
- State Tournament qualifying teams (6 White, 7 White) will be informed that they can participate in the State Tournament at their own expense. Teams will need to pay for registration fee (\$350) and accommodations.
- For 2019, we will reduce our fee to \$250 in an effort to attract more teams. We will increase the entry fee per person from \$5 to \$7 at the door for those 10+. Seniors and those 10 and under will remain free.
