On behalf of the Saskatchewan Lacrosse Association I would like to invite you to be apart of the Team Sask Program for the 2018 Lacrosse season and to attend the Box Lacrosse tryouts.

Team Sask represents the Saskatchewan Lacrosse Association and all its Member Associations at the Canadian Lacrosse Association National Championships. Being a part of the Team Sask program will give players the opportunity to have elite level training and get some more Lacrosse games in during the season. It is also a great opportunity for players to meet new friends and make great memories while showcasing their Lacrosse skills on the National level. Above all, the Team Sask program gives players the chance to represent their community and province while having FUN.

The 2018 Box Lacrosse National Championships will take place:

- Pee Wee – August 4th to 12th in Whitby, Ontario
- Bantam – August 9^h to 14th in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan
- Midget – August 12th to 19th in Calgary, Alberta

The cost to try out for the Team Sask program is \$60.00 and players will receive a Team Sask try out pinnie. Registration forms can be found at the bottom of this letter. Only electronic registration forms will be accepted, however tablets will be available at the try out sessions for those who need to fill out a form. Registrations and try out fees will be accepted until the day of try outs but are required before players step on the floor. Please bring cash or a cheque for the try out fees to the first try out session.

All players are to attend **BOTH** try out sessions. If a player is unable to make a session they will need to identify that on their registration form, so Coaches can be made aware in advance. This is so players can get the most floor time possible during try outs. All players who try out will need to be fitted for Team Sask clothing due to time constraints once the team is selected. Players only need to be fitted at one try out session. A parenting information session will be held at each try outs as well.

TEAM SASK FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q:** Does my son/daughter need to attend all the Try Out sessions?
- A:** Yes, players who are interested in trying out for Team Sask should attend as many sessions as possible. If a player is unable to attend a session they can still try out, they just need to state which sessions they can't attend on their registration forms.
- Q:** If my son/daughter makes the team, what is the commitment?
- A:** Players are expected to attend practices, exhibitions games, and then travel to Nationals with the team (this can range from 4 to 9 days, depending on which team they are on). Practice schedules are determined by the Coaches and Managers once the team is selected.
- Q:** Does my son/daughter have to play on a house league team in order to try out for Team Sask?
- A:** Yes, to be eligible to play on Team Sask, all players must be registered on a house team with their local Lacrosse Association
- Q:** My son/daughter wants to play on a "A" level elite team this year such as the Barracuda or SWAT program, are they able to play on these teams and a Team Sask team?
- A:** Absolutely, the goal of "A" elite teams is to prepare players to be in the Team Sask program and be able to represent Saskatchewan at Nationals. The "A" teams and Team Sask teams work together to prevent any conflict and to ensure all players have as many opportunities as possible to develop as elite level players. The teams will not be attending the same tournaments as each other or attending tournaments at the same time.
- Q:** If my son/daughter is selected what is the cost to be a part of Team Sask?
- A:** Each team has a different team fee as they are all traveling to different locations and are gone for different amounts of time. Team fees for specific teams will be discussed at the parent information session at Try Outs. Fundraising opportunities to help cover the cost of team fees will also be discussed at the parent information session.
- Q:** Are parents allowed to come to Nationals?
- A:** There is nothing better than having a large cheering session for the players at Nationals, so all family is welcome to attend, however parents and family members are not permitted to stay at the same hotel/dorm as the teams.
