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2018 Cheer Clinic **What You Need to Know ☺**

This is the only significant fundraiser for the Varsity squad, so it must run smoothly. We are counting on you.

All Varsity cheerleaders working at any given school constitute the team for that school. 100% participation will be required of everyone. Juniors have not yet worked a cheer clinic, and will therefore have to follow seniors' lead. Seniors, in turn, will need to set a good example, staying focused on the attendees, ensuring smooth check in and dismissal, learning of cheers, and taking of photos.

Cheerleaders should not take it upon themselves to give parents instructions. Please turn to parent volunteers for assistance. This created confusion last year.

Clinic Practice Days

- Tuesday, 9/25 and Thursday, 9/27
- Arrive at your assigned school **promptly at 3:15pm.**

Practice Day Responsibilities

- Two of the seniors should bring their megaphones for pictures
- Parent volunteers will check girls in – please assist
- Pictures will be taken on both days.
 - Juniors will be responsible for assisting with pictures
 - Picture responsibilities will include dressing each attendee in uniform (over her shorts and tee), snapping two photos with the help of parent volunteers, and escorting attendees back to the gym.
 - Seniors teach cheers while pictures are being taken

Game Day Responsibilities

- Arrive at the High School at 5:30 PM ***ready*** to accept clinic participants. No one should be running to the bathroom to do make up, put on player's numbers/tattoos etc.
- Each school will have a different color bow
- Plan some organized activity/game for the girls to play while they wait.
- Line girls up for the movement into the stadium.
- During the game, keep them cheering - that's what the parents want to see.
- There will be no bathroom runs except for emergencies. Parent volunteers with clearances will assist with any emergencies.
- Kindergarten and 1st grade will only be cheering 1st quarter – others will be released when 5 minutes before halftime
- Girls will be taken to visitor's gate for parent pick up.
- Parent volunteers will sign girls out.
- Keep track of your group at all times
